

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how Fulgur Ventures (“Fulgur Ventures”, “we”, “us” or “our”) processes personal data when using the Fulgur Ventures website.

This Privacy Policy is drawn up in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR), where applicable. It applies to the processing of personal data described below when using the Fulgur Ventures website.

1. Updates, changes, and additions

We may update this Privacy Policy when the website changes, the procedure for processing personal data changes, legal requirements change, or regulatory clarifications are issued. The “Last updated” date at the end of this Privacy Policy indicates the date of its last revision. Any changes take effect from the date of publication unless otherwise specified.

2. Privacy Notice

This Privacy Policy is intended to inform website users and other persons whose personal data is processed by Fulgur Ventures in connection with the use of the website and the submission of investment or funding applications.

3. How to read this privacy notice

For each processing operation described below, we indicate:

- the purpose of the processing;
- the categories of personal data being processed;
- the legal basis used;
- the retention period or the criteria for determining it;
- the categories of recipients; and
- if applicable, the transfer of personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

3.1.1. Submission and review of investment and funding applications

Purpose of processing: to receive and initially review investment and funding applications, to make a decision on whether to continue or terminate their review, and to communicate with the applicant regarding such an application.

The personal data and information provided via the form:

- Name;
- E-Mail;
- Company name;
- Website;
- Link to materials / attachment;

- Target geographies;
- Stage;
- Amount being raised;
- Committed amount;
- What is your vision?

Data submission requirement: to submit an application, you must provide Name, E-Mail, Company Name, Website, Target Geographies, Stage, Amount Raising, Amount Committed, and What is your vision?, as well as provide a link to materials or upload a file. It is also necessary to confirm that you have read the Privacy Policy. Failure to provide the required data or materials will prevent you from submitting an application via the form.

Legal basis for processing. Fulgur Ventures processes the applicant's personal data primarily on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

Fulgur Ventures' legitimate interest is to determine whether a voluntarily submitted investment proposal meets Fulgur Ventures' investment criteria, to decide whether to continue or terminate its consideration, and to maintain working communication with the applicant. This processing is necessary for this purpose: without the contact details and information provided in the form, Fulgur Ventures will not be able to review the proposal or contact the applicant regarding its results. Fulgur Ventures limits the processing to data related to the application and does not use it for purposes unrelated to its review and communication regarding

The retention period for personal data: personal data is processed until the interaction with the applicant regarding the relevant application is completed. If, based on the results of the review, an agreement is concluded with the applicant or the organization they represent, the personal data necessary for concluding and executing the agreement is processed during the term of the agreement, and after its termination — during the storage periods provided for by applicable law and the need to establish, implement, or protect legal claims. If an agreement is not concluded, the personal data is deleted or irreversibly anonymized no later than 30 calendar days after the completion of interaction regarding the application.

Recipients: access to personal data is granted to authorized persons of Fulgur Ventures who need such access to process the application and communicate with the applicant.

Disclosure by law: Fulgur Ventures may disclose personal data if required by applicable law or by a lawful demand of a competent public authority.

4. Your rights

Subject to the conditions and restrictions established by the GDPR, you may have the following rights in relation to your personal data:

- the right of access (Article 15 GDPR);
- the right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR);
- the right to erasure (Article 17 GDPR);

- the right to restrict processing (Article 18 GDPR);
- the right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR), if applicable;
- the right to object (Article 21 GDPR); and
- the right to file a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.

To exercise your rights, send a request via email: contact@fulgur.ventures. We will respond to your inquiry within the timeframes provided for by the applicable legislation. If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the applicable data protection legislation, you may file a complaint with the supervisory authority of the EU/EEA member state where you have your habitual residence, place of work, or the place of the alleged violation, if applicable.
